1. Contextes and references

The globalization affects the identity issues particularly in those contexts like the Mediterranean where the individual's representations are strictly linked to dominant groups' dynamics on the linguistic, social, cultural, ethnic and religious plans. Even the historical formation of the states, along with the educational and cultural policies, enter the degree in which communities and individuals enjoy the sense of authonomy in their own territories: in many cases those processes end in the constitution of a national identity, normative in its history, up to the imposition of one only monoculturalism.

It often happens that nowadays the educational policies, led till now by the state-nations with uniformation and assimilation as their main aims, sharply contrast with the new trends as instaured by new super-national Institutions (UNESCO, Europe, and the likes) and bodies (families, communities, associations, syndicates, religions-based communities, etc.). Those new tensions shed a new light upon the "cultural democracy gap", a defaillance that cannot but result in a intensification of the conflicts related to the

linguistic and cultural hegemony.

The theme of the capability to live together therefore becomes a crucial social matter that claims for a re-consideration of the organization of the city as the venue where each part should find its niche, with its legitimization and constitution. That's why a space for re-elaborating a new "educational contract" becomes so opportune and urgent, with the aim to find practical solutions for integrating interculturalism and plurilinguism.

2. Aims and themes

Taking in consideration the aforementioned perspective, the Vth MESCE Congress offers the opportunity for a fundamental reflection upon the role that the educational systems should play in order to appropriately treating the differences.

MESCE minds to open a debate for the researchers in Education, Sciences of Language, Sociology, Cultural Anthropology, Psychology, Philosophy, Sociolinguistics, Politology and Law. Here below follows the list of the axes proposed for the debate:

- 1 Axe 1 : Territories, minorities and cultural citizenship
